



Dr. Jean-Bernard Memet is a professional diver and marine corrosion doctor specialised in harbour and petroleum infrastructures and underwater cultural heritage. He is specialised in electrochemistry, treatment of huge artefacts and on site measurements and assessment. He worked for 5 years as Head of the underwater department of Arc' Antique laboratory, the largest laboratory in France dedicated to the conservation and restoration of underwater heritage artefacts. He was in charge of the conservation and restoration of the French underwater archaeological collection, particularly the large scale artefacts. Since 2007, Jean-Bernard Memet has founded the A-CORROS company which is specialised either in expertise and diagnosis of corrosion and conservation of underwater and terrestrial metallic cultural heritage (archaeological artefacts, shipwrecks) or industrial heritage (rail stations, bridges and metallic structures in maritime environments). He has taken an active part in the making of the Cluster since its beginning in 2007 as Advisor to the President, and was elected Vice President for the Business College in 2013.
